It is important that you read all the information carefully and comply with all the instructions sent to avoid any unnecessary problems.

TEAM DECLARATIONS:

Your team declarations should be posted on the YDL Team Manager's portal by Thursday 4th September 2025; this will allow for registration checks to be completed. Please note if athletes are not registered, they will not be eligible to compete in this year's National Finals.

Declarations must be made on the Team Manager's Portal. I'm sure you are familiar with the manager's portal by now, but instructions for using the portal are available in the documents area on the league's web site, ukydl.org.uk if needed.

Any changes to your declared team MUST be made on the team manager's portal. A printed copy of your updated declaration must be handed into the results team who will be situated in the Results Area – first floor of Liverpool Harriers clubhouse, next to photo finish, by 10.00 am on the day of the competition, highlighting any changes.

Any further changes during the day MUST be made using the team manager's portal, well in advance of the event start time and no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. Again, to ensure start lists and field cards are up to date.

Please Note, Access to the 'Results Area' will be restricted to team managers only.

COMPETITION NUMBERS:

You will be issued with new competition (bib) numbers (as indicated on page 1)

PLEASE NOTE: One team manager is asked to collect your competition numbers and any other materials which you may require from the official reception area.

Numbers should be worn as supplied and not folded or otherwise modified as this may cause disqualification.

Team Managers are asked to ensure that they have an adequate supply of pins with them as the YDL will not be providing pins.

Pins must be used to secure numbers front and back with a pin at each corner, in all track events; in field events one is permissible worn either on the front or back. (4 pins in each number)

HEALTH & SAFETY:

In line with other competition providers, the YDL Committee wants to ensure the safety of athletes, officials and spectators throughout the weekend.

The indoor area will be available for WARM UP, team managers will be responsible for the supervision of the athletes. No food or drink to be taken into the indoor warm up area, except water.

REPORTING TIMES & ACCESS POINTS:

There is no call room, team managers must therefore ensure that all athletes report for their event on time (see below).

Only athletes who are competing will be allowed into the competition area.

The right to remove anyone who is found to be in breach of any of these requirements is maintained.

TRACK:

Athletes MUST assemble outside the track near to the start of their track event, **ten minutes before** the event is due to start, and wait until they are called in by the Starters Assistant. They must be ready to race.

It will be the Team Manager's responsibility to ensure that athletes are there. No races will be held up waiting for athletes.

Team Managers should also ensure that relay athletes know their relevant takeover markings and rules.

WA & UKA Competition Rules. TR 24 Relays

Starter's Assistants and Track Umpires may not have time to explain the rule to athletes at the takeovers.

FIELD:

Athletes **MUST** assemble outside the track near to the access point for their designated event, as shown on the stadium layout plan, available to download from the YDL web site. Athletes will be led to their event site by one of the field officials.

Athletes will have a minimum of **ONE WARM UP** trial, a second trial will be allowed, time permitting. Events **MUST** start on time.

There is no dress code, but it will be expected that all officials will wear appropriate clothing for this level of meeting. Please ensure all your officials bring their UKA license, as their accreditation.

Teams must also declare their officials on the team manager portal.

Travel expenses will not be paid to your club officials; they are expected to travel with the team. Packed lunches will be available for all declared officials. *Officials are requested to bring their own cups for refreshments.*

The Meeting Manager will be available to offer advice to team managers but will not overrule referees' decisions.

Presentation will be made to the "A" and "B" event athletes placed 1, 2 or 3 throughout the day.

Relay medals can be collected by the team managers, after relay results have been confirmed, these will not be presented to athletes.

Team Awards will be presented along with a set of results at the end of the meeting. Please ensure someone is available to receive your club's trophy at the end of the match.
