YDL Annual Report for 2020

2020 has been a very strange year indeed, not one we hope to repeat, although the future is very hard to predict at the moment.

It's been uplifting to note that some athletics competitions did take place towards the latter half of the season, with some of our clubs hosting a number of these. I imagine we'll be using their experience quite a lot when it comes around to organising fixtures in 2021.

Although we made the decision to cancel our league fixtures early on in the year, nevertheless a lot of work had already been undertaken sorting out divisional structures and finding venues, and we thank the Area Co-ordinators for their hard work with this; we are now looking ahead to next year's competition.

With no results to scrutinise the Administrator used some of the time to build up a database of leagues and open meetings which took place during 2019, this has helped to identify what competition took place for the differing age groups, as well as identify which events were covered in each region, and which were not. This may help us going forward to help to ensure that all age groups and all events are sufficiently catered for, and accessible, across the mainland of GB. The Chair meanwhile started to make inroads into checking the YDL team managers' portals, making sure that all new addition were checked and any queries sorted. She consequently identified a flaw in the system whereby U20 athletes had not been moved up to seniors and this was passed on to the software developer to be resolved.

We're still unsure exactly what format the league will be using next year but it is our solid belief that league competitions are the life-blood of the sport and we will do the utmost to ensure that there will be competition for all those athletes who want to represent their clubs in competition. We will be consulting our member clubs to try to find the best way through the uncertainties we are facing and welcome their input into planning a programme of fixtures that best suits the athletes and clubs.

With regard to fixture planning for 2021, we have been involved in the Domestic Competition Open Forum, and also the newly formed Focus group; we hope that by working together with the National and Area leagues we can try to avoid some of the clashes that could have caused problems this year. Inevitably there will be some but by ensuring that there is an accepted hierarchy within the structure we would aim to make this as minimal as possible. In previous years, the UKA fixture conference did try to address this.

We left our AGM last year with one of two changes for the 2020 season and, as the vast majority of clubs were happy to defer this year's AGM due to Coronavirus, and maintain the status quo, any such changes will now be implemented in 2021 wherever possible and assessed at the end of the season.

As some of you will be aware, there are changes afoot in our governing body structures following various reviews, and we ask that you try to make yourselves aware of these. Some of the proposed changes may change the sport we all love into something you may not want. Look beyond the headlines and ask yourselves did anyone consult directly with your club during the summer of 2020. Possibly not, but......

We would like to thank all our member clubs for their support and look forward to working with you again in 2021.

YDL Finance Officers Report to the AGM 2020

It has been an unusual year. The league functioned normally in preparation for the 2020 competitive season until April when the League Committee made the decision to defer the competitive season to 2021 due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Summary Explanation of 2019-20 Accounts

Income

All team affiliations and grant income received has been deferred to the 2020-21 season (£140,090 – Income deferred on the Balance sheet).

Expenditure

Effectively for six months the league had the usual running costs in preparing for the competitive season. After consultation with officers on the committee, where possible the preparation work and expenses (that can be transferred) have been transferred to the 2020-21 season (included in Debtors on the Balance sheet – Note 2).

Forecast Budget.

This has been prepared with the assumption that the league will function next year as previously planned. This is by no means certain, but it is the preferred option if the situation allows. No changes have been made to the team and host support that was offered and agreed at the last AGM.

Grants

The league received the expected £50,000 from UKA in 2020 as part of the previous agreed funding round. Any funding from UKA from April 2021 onwards has yet to be established.

Contingency

Fortunately the league had built up reserves from increased affiliation fees over the previous two years as a contingency for unforeseen circumstances.

The costs of running the league during 2019-20 (that could not be transferred) have been funded from the league's contingency.

There is further contingency available to support the league function if required but caution is recommended as much of the contingency has been accumulated to reduce reliance on external grants of which there is no guarantee.
